The Colorado Health Foundation and Kaiser Permanente Colorado are accepting proposals for planning grants of up to \$85,000. Each grant will support a coalition of partners to develop strategic implementation plans within a nine-month timeframe to address one or both of the following [Colorado Blueprint to End Hunger](#) goals:

- Goal 2: Increase the number of Coloradans who can access affordable, nutritious food in their communities
- Goal 3: Increase the number of Coloradans who can access food assistance and nutritious food through community-based organizations
