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For 10 years, the Colorado Health Foundation, in partnership with the Colorado Health Institute, published the Colorado Health Report Card, an annual update

examining the current status of health in the state. The Health Report Card provides a benchmark for measuring progress on some of the state’s most pressing health issues across 38 key health indicators and through five life stages: *Healthy Beginnings*, *Healthy Children*, *Healthy Adolescents*, *Healthy Adults* and *Healthy Aging*.
