Waneta Timmerman knew she needed expensive surgery. She could feel it, literally in her bones. Standing up all day on the hard floor of her bustling beauty shop in Brighton eventually left Timmerman in so much pain that even long hot baths at the end of the evening couldn't help. A hip replacement cost her \$2,000 out of pocket. Timmerman is now styling hair pain-free, and “everything is going great.”
