



LEGAL RESOURCES FOR NONPROFITS

NONPROFIT WORKING GROUP

The Colorado Lawyers Committee partners with the Colorado Nonprofit Association to provide free legal advice to small Colorado nonprofits that can't otherwise afford legal services. Assistance is offered for requests on transactional-type (no litigation) matters (e.g., contracts, employment, etc.). Each request is emailed to a legal listserv and given to the first lawyer who responds. Most requests result in short term relationships, although sometimes a lawyer may choose to continue the relationship. NONPROFIT LEGAL AUDIT CLINIC

The Colorado Lawyers Committee partners with the Colorado Nonprofit Association, the Association of Corporate Counsel-Colorado Chapter and other organizations to provide a two-hour clinic where small nonprofits meet with teams of lawyers to review the nonprofit's legal health.
