


COMMUNITY INVESTMENT

The Colorado Health Foundation's vision is "Together, we will make Colorado the healthiest state in the nation." We believe "together" is the most important word in that statement. The majority of our annual investment goes directly to grants and contributions to nonprofit organizations, government agencies and other groups that work to improve health and health care in Colorado.

We also operate and fund six graduate medical education residency programs that train physicians. Our yearly spending in these areas represents our total annual community investment.



- GRANTS AND CONTRIBUTIONS represent funds committed by the Foundation's Board to be distributed directly to nonprofit and public organizations and do not include expenses associated with grant administration.
- GRADUATE MEDICAL EDUCATION represents the investment required to operate the Rose and Swedish Family Medicine residencies, the Transitional Year Internship, the University of Colorado's Internal Medicine Residency at Presbyterian/St. Luke's Medical Center Uptown Primary Care, the Highlands Podiatric Medicine and Surgery Residency.
- OTHER PROGRAMS represents the subsidies required to operate Foundation initiatives including the Colorado Health Symposium and the Colorado Health Report Card, as well as restricted fund expenditures.
