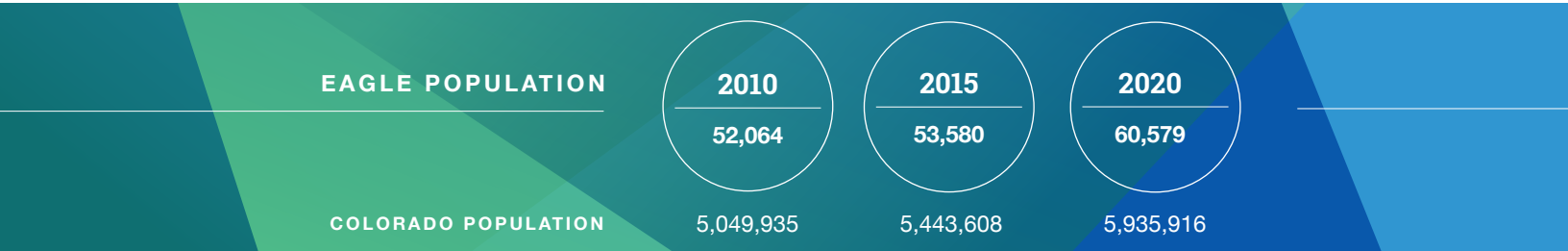

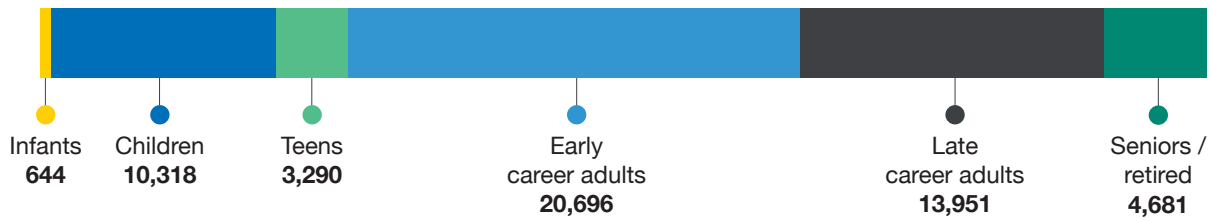
Geographic Concentration: Rural

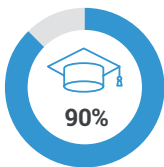
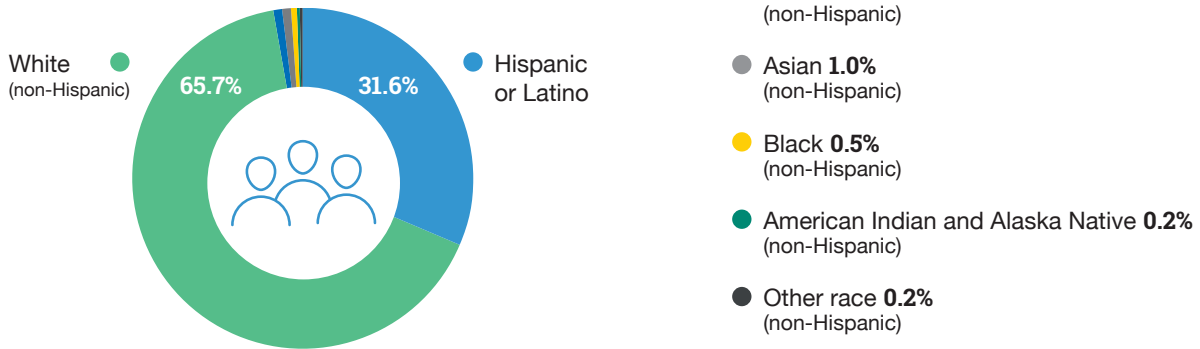

The following captures local age breakouts by the population.



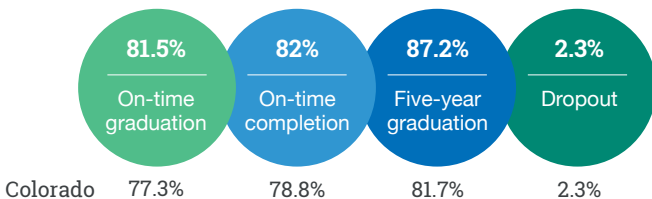

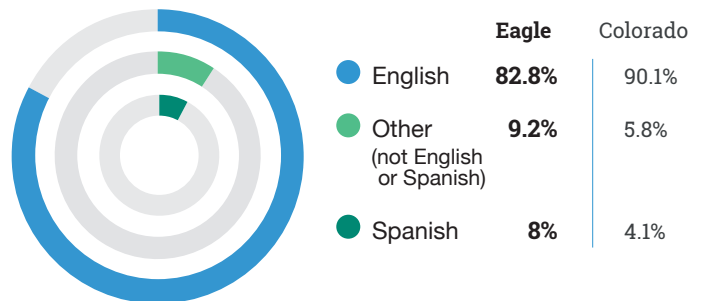
HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA OR HIGHER

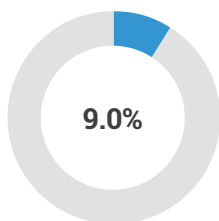

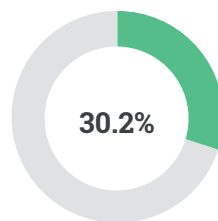
