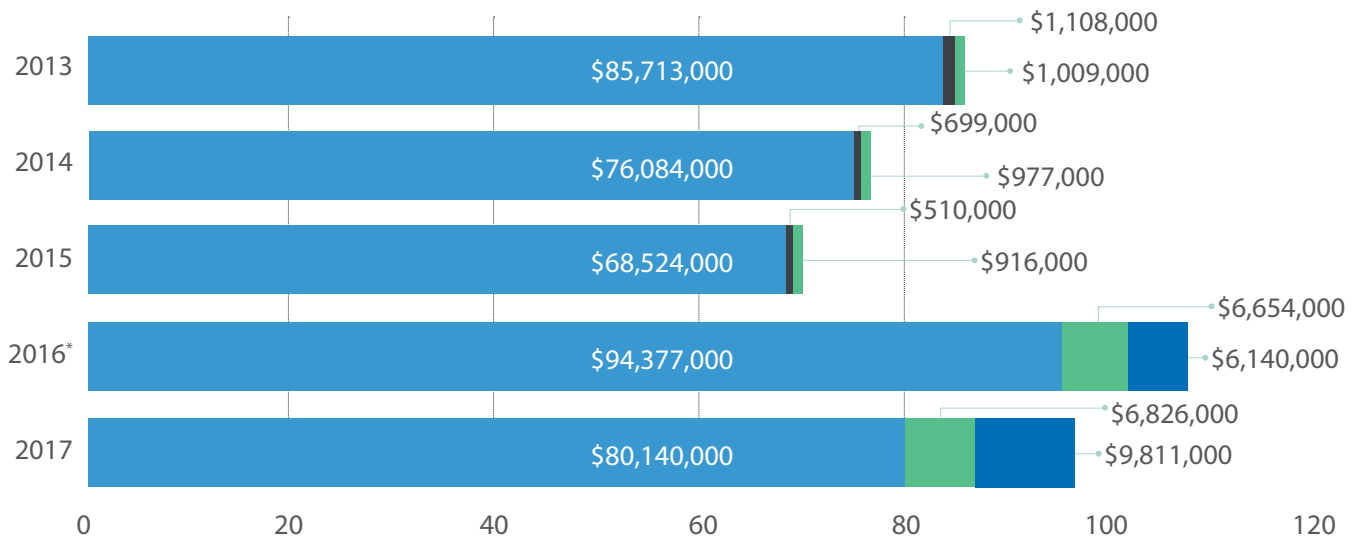

COMMUNITY INVESTMENT

The Colorado Health Foundation's vision is that across Colorado, each of us can say: "We have all we need to live healthy lives." The majority of our annual investment goes directly to grants and contributions to nonprofit organizations, government agencies and other groups that work to improve the health of Coloradans.



GRANTS AND CONTRIBUTIONS represent funds committed by the Foundation's Board to be distributed directly to nonprofit and public organizations and do not include expenses associated with grant administration.

GRADUATE MEDICAL EDUCATION represents the investment required to operate the Rose and Swedish Family Medicine residencies, the Transitional Year Internship, the University of Colorado's Internal Medicine Residency at Presbyterian/St. Luke's Medical Center Uptown Primary Care, and the Highlands Podiatric Medicine and Surgery Residency.

DIRECT CHARITABLE ACTIVITIES represents amounts paid, other than grants, for activities such as education and evaluation that directly benefit Colorado communities.

PROGRAM-RELATED INVESTMENTS represent below-market interest loans made to various local organizations to fund projects that fulfill the charitable mission of the Foundation.
